
He will lead sessions every other Friday, teaching entrepreneurship, investments, and the basics of stocks and bonds.

As a proud University High School alumna, this was a full-circle moment for Ms. Tucker–especially seeing her former school social worker from 2004 still serving students with dedication.


The scholars were active, thoughtful, and even presented Ms. Tucker with a T-shirt from the Class of 2029!




